Workshops

 Drama Enrichment (6 week block of 1hr sessions) – a series of workshops designed to improve confidence and develop speaking, listening and cooperation skills through creative exploration of the themes of Hare and Tortoise = £500 +VAT

Cost and How to Book

<u>Early Bird Offer</u>: £200 +VAT per performance if booked before 20th October 2023.

£250 +VAT per performance thereafter. Workshops are an additional fee.

Technical Requirements

- Minimum performance area of 5m x 5m (exclusive access), plus additional space for the audience to sit in (a combination of floor mats and benches).
- Undisturbed access to a dedicated performance space from arrival.
- Access to a parking space suitable for a long wheel base splitter van, ideally situated in close proximity to the performance to enable quick loading and unloading.
- Access to and use of one 13 amp plug socket and designated changing area for the actors. This could be a staff toilet.
- If you are booking 2 or more performances in one day, we ask that you please provide our three performers with lunch.

Additional Information

The performance is designed for an audience of up to 90 people. We are happy to discuss accommodating different audience sizes on a case by case basis.

The performance will last approximately 45 minutes.
